About the Communicator Awards

The Communicator Awards is the leading international award program honoring creative excellence for communications professionals. Founded by communication professionals over a decade ago, The Communicator Awards is an annual competition honoring the best in advertising, corporate communications, public relations and identity work for print, video, interactive and audio. And for the first time this year, The Communicator Awards will also honor the best in Marketing Effectiveness and Integrated Campaigns. The past year's 14th Annual Communicator Awards received approximately 5,000 entries from corporations and agencies of all sizes, making it one of the largest awards of its kind in the world. The Communicator Awards provides winners and their clients the recognition they deserve and gives communications and creative professionals great and highly regarded by their peers. The Communicator Awards provides an equal chance of winning to all entrants regardless of company or agency size and project budget. The Award of Excellence, our highest honor, is given to those entries whose ability to communicate puts them among the best in the field. The Award of Distinction is presented for projects that exceed industry standards in quality and achievement.

Judging

Winning entries for The Communicator Awards are selected by the International Academy of the Visual Arts. The IAVA now oversees all judging and makes the strategic direction for The Communicator Awards program. The IAVA is a membership-based organization of leading professionals from various disciplines of the visual arts dedicated to enhancing progress and the evolving nature of traditional and interactive media. To learn more about the International Academy of the Visual Arts, please visit www.iavaarts.org. All decisions of the judges are final. Entries are subject to evaluation discretion in creative work.

In determining Excellence and Distinction Winners, entries are judged on their merits against a standard of excellence based on the 15-year history of The Communicator Awards, considering the category entered. A category may have multiple winners, or only one winner. Entries are scored on a ten point scale by the judges. Generally, Excellence Winners receive a score of 9.0 or above and Distinction Winners receive a score of 7.0 to 8.9.

Eligibility

The competition is open to all companies, agencies, organizations or individuals involved in producing communication materials for external or internal audiences. To be eligible for a Communicator Award, an entry must have been produced after Jan. 1, 2007 (there is a two-year window of eligibility).



Winner Notification

The Communicator Awards recognizes that entrants want to know the results as soon as possible and will make every effort to notify entrants of the status of their entries within 60 days after the final entry deadline. Included with the notification is information that winners can use in their marketing materials and web sites, and in preparing releases for their local news media, clients and prospects. Winners will be listed on The Communicator Awards website at www.communicatorawards.com. Since The Communicator Awards makes its competition accessible to more people by keeping its entry fees low, Excellence and Distinction winners will be charged \$150 if they wish to communicate the achievement with a custom engraved Communicator statuette as well as a framed commemorative certificate. Additional certificates and awards are available.

Entries

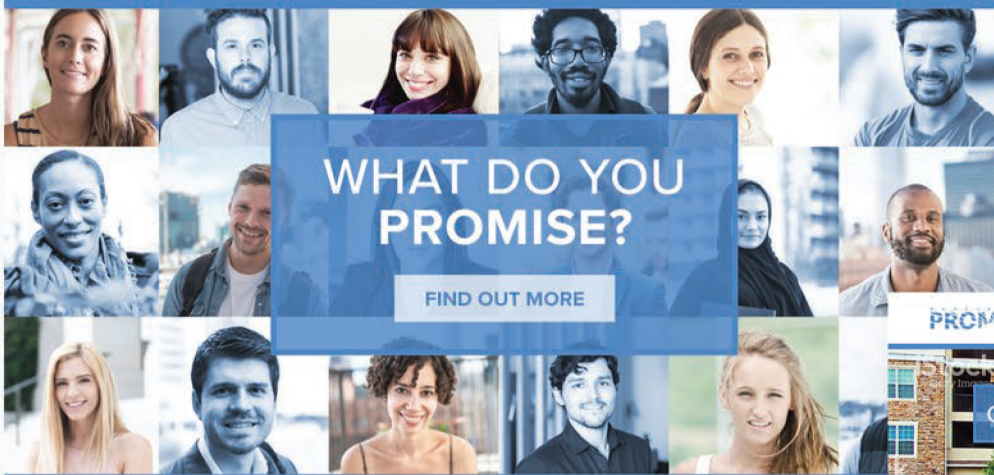

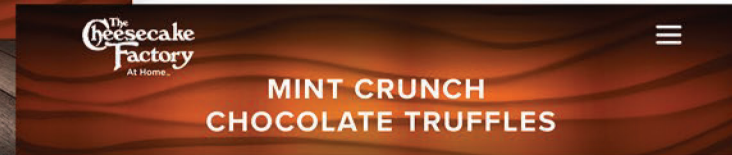
